

URGENT NOTICE

WATER RESTRICTIONS

TO ALL RESIDENTS AND WATER USERS OF WOWAN

Commencing 21 December 2006

In accordance with the provisions of the Water Act 2000, all residents and water users connected to the town water supply of Wowan are advised that the following water restrictions shall apply commencing immediately, and they shall remain in place until further written notice:

- EXTERNAL HOUSEHOLD WATER USES: **PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES**
Sprinklers and unattended hoses for any use including garden watering. Limited watering of gardens using one (1) hand held hose only will be permitted between 6:00pm and 8:00am. **Users are respectfully requested to limit watering to a maximum of one hour on any day**, however residents may choose when they wish to water between the range of times nominated. The aim is to provide flexibility to residents and avoid placing large demands on the system at any particular time.

- HOUSEHOLD INTERNAL WATER USES: ***PERMITTED to be used at any time.***

Note: Restrictions do not apply to the supply of water for drinking purposes for domestic pets. Potted household plants may be hand watered with a hose, but residents are respectfully requested to limit any such watering and conserve water for essential household use only at this time.

A person must not contravene a water restriction - Maximum penalty two hundred (200) penalty units.

These restrictions are necessary to maintain a minimum supply of water for essential domestic purposes. Residents and other water users are requested to minimise the extent and duration of outside watering so as not to exceed the capacity of available water. These restrictions will remain in force until the new pump is installed in the bore.
