JUDGE MARK COOMBE

I spent most of my primary school years on Waverley Station near St. Lawrence in Central Queensland, my dad, Ken managed this 80 odd thousand acre property for Stanbroke Pastoral Company. I attended boarding school in Rockhampton for five years in the late seventies and then enjoyed four years at Gatton Agricultural College.

In the early nineties I decided to capture the rural life that my work had moved me away from. So with camera and saddle I headed out into stock camps all over Australia and over a period of 6 years published three books; "A Taste of the Land", "Leather Dust Tin and Rust" and "A Day in the Outback" which I'm happy to say sold out. Painting has always been something I wanted to do, but felt it was beyond my ability.

However by 2013 the kids had left home and I'm thinking, surely if someone else can paint then I can as well. So as the saying goes, if you want to do something enough, then you can do it. I think it was a case of being persistent enough to keep doing whatever I had to do to improve.

BRIGALOW ARTS FESTIVAL - GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PLEASE READ THE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY CAREFULLY

ENTRANTS

- 1. Brigalow Arts Festival welcomes artists of all ages.
- 2. Artists must be 18 years and older to be eligible for acquisition prizes. Acquisitive selections are the choice of the Sponsor and not reliant on the judges winning choices.
- 3. Youth Encouragement Award is based on all works submitted by artists under 18.
- 4. Emerging Artist is defined as "someone who is 18 years or over, has not won a major art prize or scholarship in an open art exhibition, nor has held a solo exhibition.
- The winner of Section 5 wins the Friends of McGregor Winter School Scholarship for Tuition July 2019 in Toowoomba.

ENTRY

- 6. Entry Fees: Sections 1 to 8 \$15 per artwork. Sections 9 to 12 \$1 per artwork.
- 7. All entry fees are non-refundable and **must** accompany the Entry Form.
- 8. Due Date: Entry Fees together with completed entry form must be received by **4pm Monday 24th September 2018**. No late entries will be accepted after this closing date.

ARTWORK

- 9. All entries must be the original work of the artist. Work must be uncopied, unaided and completed after October 2017. Works started or aided at workshops are not eligible.
- 10. No work can be entered in more than one section. Limit of four artworks per exhibitor.
- 11. All entries must be for sale.
 A commission of 25% will be levied on sales.
- 12. All works requiring hanging should have suitable attachments. All framed works must have "D" rings and picture wire 10cm down from the top of the frame or may not be hung.
- 13. Unframed work must include clear instructions for hanging or may not be hung.
- 14. Three dimensional work will be displayed on flat surfaces. Suitable stands or supports must be included where necessary.
- 15. Photography Section 8 can be on paper or canvas and can be unframed.
- 16. Sections 9 and 10, all art must be the work of the entrant.
- 17. Each work must not exceed 1.2 metres in any direction for framed work this includes the frame. In the event of space being limited, the committee reserves the right, in consultation with the Judge to hang a selection of work only.
- Each entry must be clearly marked with: Name, Address, Title of Work, Section Numbers and Selling Price (attach label provided on the back bottom right hand corner).

ARTWORK DELIVERY

- 19. Artwork must arrive between **9am and 4pm on Wednesday 3th October 2018** to the Banana Shire Regional Art Gallery.
 - a. No artworks will be accepted at Banana Shire Regional Art Gallery prior to Wednesday 3rd October
 - b. Early deliveries: Deliveries before Wednesday 3rd October must be delivered to: Callide Dawson Insurance & Financial Services, 55 Kariboe Street Biloela **OR** to Biloela Couriers Thangool Road, Biloela.
 - c. Postal entries: Artwork being sent by Australia Post must be addressed to "BRIGALOW ARTS FESTIVAL", PO Box 335 Biloela, QLD 4715.
 - d. Special arrangements can be made by contacting 0466 015 337 or 4992 2525 or 4995 7271
 - e. Late deliveries will be viewed by the judge but may NOT be hung.

ARTWORK COLLECTION

- Artworks must be collected between 12 Noon and 4pm on Saturday 17th November 2018. No responsibility will be accepted for unclaimed items.
 - a. Postal/courier entries: All freight, insurance and transport costs are to be met by the artist. Return freight costs to be included with the entry fee.
 Consignment notes, prepaid vouchers or postage stamps etc. must be enclosed with entry form.
 Pre-paid freight will be refunded in the event of a sale.

OTHER

- 21. Entrants shall allow their work to be reproduced in the Media without fee for the promotion of the exhibition.
- 22. The Judge's decision will be final and binding. No correspondence or discussion regarding the decision will be entered into. The Judge and the committee shall reserve the right to withdraw the prize if the required standard is not met, or if the number of entries are inadequate for the section.
- 23. The Committee exercises all due care in exhibiting and handling the artworks submitted, but works shall at all times be at the risk of the entrant. The Committee accepts no liability for any loss or damage, either in transit or while entries are in the custody of the Committee.
- 24. The Committee and Judge have the final decision on the suitability of exhibiting any works entered and reserve the right to reject any entry without explanation.

Brigalow Arts Festival Committee will stage Art Workshops in conjunction with the Festival.
Arrangements will be advised as to Tutor, Workshop them, date, time and location.
