PROCEDURE

Approved Sites

- Council collate a list of approved sites for public art mural projects to be maintained by the Arts and Cultural Officer.
- Individual sites may be listed covering the whole of an area or may be split to accommodate multiple murals.
- Requests for sites to be added to the list of approved sites to be managed by the Arts and Cultural Officer.
- The Arts and Cultural Officer will consult with relevant internal sections of Council prior to recommending any additional sites. e.g. Parks and Gardens, Water and Sewerage, Planning and Development etc.
- That applications be assessed against Planning and Local Law requirements and Council's Community Plan when formulating any recommendations.
- Recommendations are to be submitted to the CEO for approval.
- The CEO may consult with Council or EMT.

APPLICANTS

- A community group or organisation or an individual may apply to Council to undertake mural projects on approved Council sites/facilities.
- Council may undertake community art projects or commission an artist/s to create murals on these sites/facilities.

APPLICATION AND DESIGN CONTENT

- The application and proposed mural design and project outlines must be submitted using the approved form.
- Designs must have no swear or offensive words, or obscene or offensive drawings.
- Designs are recommended to include local content and/or tell the story of the locality or community.
- Each approved site may have its own set of specific design conditions.

CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL

- Murals must be created using industry appropriate materials ensuring longevity of the design.

LIFE SPAN

- The applicant may apply for permission to create a mural with a short or long term life span.
- Short term life span is for a period up to 12 months. The applicant may request permission to amend or replace the mural a number of times within this period however each design must be submitted to the Arts and Cultural officer for prior approval.
- Long Term is for the life span of the structure or other any other period in excess of 12 months.

END OF LIFE

- In the event of the mural becomes vandalised, outdated, dilapidated or otherwise unattractive it may be refreshed, painted over or upgraded to a new design.
- The Arts and Cultural Officer may request the applicant to refresh, paint over or upgrade the mural.
- The Arts and Cultural Officer may arrange for the mural to be painted over if the applicant is unavailable or unwilling to comply with the above request.

NON COMPLIANCE

If the conditions, especially regarding the content of the mural are not complied with the wall or other structure will be re-coated and artist's/groups approval is cancelled.
