SCOPE

Other than major projects that will be provided for in Council's Budget, Council will deal with requests for streetlighting in accordance with this policy.

OBJECTIVE

To control the installation and maintenance of Street Lighting and set the conditions, under which Council will approve their installation.

DEFINITIONS

"Council" means Banana Shire Council.

"Ergon Energy" means power/ energy supplier.

Australian Standard 1158.4. - "Streetlighting" is the current legislation relating to street lighting.

POLICY

Council provides streetlighting in streets of towns within Banana Shire and proposes to have the system upgraded to meet Australian Standard 1158.4. - "Streetlighting".

PROCEDURE

1. Requests for streetlighting in areas within Council's townships will be referred to Ergon Energy for their assessment and recommendations in accordance with AS1158.4.

2. The Director of Infrastructure Services will authorise the installation of streetlighting in accordance with Ergon Energy's recommendation, provided it is within budget limit. If the recommendation is not to install lights no action will be taken.
3. Council will follow up on requests referred to Ergon Energy if no advice is received from them within 90 days.
4. The requestee and Council will be advised of the outcome of the request.
