<b>CONDITIONS</b>	<p>See <a href="http://www.asbestos.qld.gov.au">www.asbestos.qld.gov.au</a> for all required information in handling asbestos. State legislation requires a Class A Asbestos Licence for the removal of friable asbestos, and a Class B Asbestos Licence for the removal of more than 10 m<sup>2</sup> of bonded asbestos. Council will not accept asbestos waste exceeding 10 m<sup>2</sup> (wrapped 175 kg maximum) from a single household in accordance with current legislation, which is not transported by a licensed contractor.</p> <p><b>As a minimum:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Asbestos sheeting is to be wetted and either:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Wrapped and sealed in two layers of heavy-duty, minimum of 0.2 mm thick plastic sheeting in quantities able to be handled by the person disposing of the waste and sufficiently sealed to prevent dust emissions; or</li> <li>(b) Double bagged in plastic bags that are at least 0.2 mm thick and no more than 1200 mm long &amp; 900 mm wide and sufficiently sealed – <b>DO NOT overfill bag (FREE information guides are available from the Council at the Biloela, Moura and Taroom Offices).</b> Any loads not found to have complied with this requirement may have their load rejected.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2) The packaging/bag is to be marked in contrasting colours with the warning “CAUTION - Contains Asbestos Material, Do Not Damage or Open Bag, Do Not Inhale Dust,” and the lettering no less than 20 mm.</li> <li>3) Material is to be neatly and tidily placed at the identified location to enable coverage by Trap Gully operators. The plastic wrapping/lining is not to be damaged during unloading.</li> <li>4) Dispose at Trap Gully Landfill, 142 Forestry Rd, Biloela, between 8.00 am to 3.00 pm, Monday to Friday.</li> <li>5) A minimum of 24 hours' notice of disposal is required. Follow site operator instructions. A 'Notification Number' will be provided by Council prior to accepting disposal. This will need to be quoted to the site operator.</li> </ol>
