1. Description of the development to which this certificate relates

The following development is exempt under this certificate:

2. Reasons for giving exemption certificate

The development is exempt under this certificate under s46(3)(b)(i) of the Planning Act for the following reason/s:

• The effects of the development would be minor or inconsequential, considering the circumstances under which the development was categorised as assessable development.

Development for Operational works for filling is categorised as Code Assessment if in the Rural Zone. The proposed filling of material for the crane pad is estimated to be in the order of 1,750m³ of clean gravel and to a maximum fill height of 0.8m over Lot 43 on SP266150.

The proposed filling is considered not to have any permanent or significant consequences as it is required for rectification or repair works on a structure which will not affect the safety, health and or the environment of nearby residents or neighbouring properties of the structure, inclusive of other works required to support the rectification or repair works. The proposed works is to include the removal of the filling that is required for the crane pad to pre-existing condition.

The Callide Dam Radial Gate Emergency Rectification Works are considered as minor and inconsequential due to:

- The works will not result in any off-site stormwater drainage;
