SIZE REQUIREMENTS

Cats

- ☐ Approval to keep more than two (2) over 350m²

Livestock - Horses, Cattle, Sheep, Goats etc. (any combination) excluding stallions, bulls & pigs

- ☐ Approval to keep one (1) or more of the above animals on an allotment over 3,000m² in a non-rural zone (maximum density of accumulated animals must not exceed one (1) animal per 3,000m²)

Bees

- ☐ Approval to keep more than two (2) hives on an allotment area greater than 2ha (20,000m²) in a non-rural zone

Cockatoos, Galahs & Corellas (any combination)

- ☐ Approval to keep more than two (2) birds on an allotment area 2,500m² or greater in a non-rural zone

Caged Birds (budgerigar, cockatiel, canary, finch, lovebirds, parrots, etc.)

- ☐ Approval to keep more than ten (10) birds on an allotment area greater than 350m² and less than or equal to 500m² in a non-rural zone
- ☐ Approval to keep more than twenty (20) birds on an allotment area greater than 500m² in a non-rural zone

Pigeons & Doves

- ☐ Approval to keep more than ten (10) birds on an allotment area greater than 350m² and less than or equal to 500m² in a non-rural zone

Domestic Hens, Geese, Turkeys & Ducks

- ☐ Approval to keep more than four (4) of the above birds on an allotment area greater than 350m² and less than or equal to 500m² in a non-rural zone

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- ☐ Ensure that waste waters from enclosures are drained in a nuisance free manner and that run-off does not discharge to adjoining land or as otherwise directed by an authorised person; and
- ☐ Ensure that excreta, food scraps, and other material that is, or is likely to become offensive, is collected at least once in each day, and if not immediately disposed of, is kept in a fly proof container of a kind approved by an authorised person; and
- ☐ Ensure that any enclosure in which the animal/s is/are kept in a clean and sanitary condition and free from dust and odour; and
- ☐ Ensure that any enclosure in which the animal is kept is properly maintained in an aesthetically acceptable condition; and
- ☐ Take all reasonable steps to prevent the animal/s from making any noise or disturbance that causes a nuisance or disturbance to the occupiers of other land or premises; and
- ☐ Ensure that the area available to the animal/s kept on the premises is appropriately sized so that the animal can be effectively and comfortably kept; and
- ☐ Any animal food is stored in an impervious fly proof and vermin proof receptacle or in an impervious fly proof and vermin proof storeroom facility and the receptacle or storeroom facility, as the case may be, is maintained to the satisfaction of an authorised person; and
- ☐ Ensure that all animals kept on the premises are provided with and have access to adequate shelter, drinking water and appropriate food; and
- ☐ Ensure that any enclosure used for the purpose of keeping an animal is thoroughly cleaned at least once a week and effectively treated with an insecticide at least twice a year; and
- ☐ Comply with reasonable directions given by an authorised person to ensure that the keeping of the animal/s does not result in nuisance to occupiers of other land or premises, including direction for the treatment of transmittable infections of ticks, fleas or mange; and
- ☐ Animals must not be allowed to wander at large; and
- ☐ Cattle must wear identifying tags.
