Ensure that any enclosure in which the animal is kept is properly maintained in an aesthetically acceptable condition; and Take all reasonable steps to prevent the animal/s from making any noise or disturbance that causes a nuisance or disturbance to the occupiers of other land or premises; and Ensure that the area available to the animal/s kept on the premises is appropriately sized so that the animal can be effectively and comfortably kept; and Any animal food is stored in an impervious fly proof and vermin proof receptacle or in an impervious fly proof and vermin proof storeroom facility and the receptacle or storeroom facility, as the case may be, is maintained to the satisfaction of an authorised person; and Ensure that all animals kept on the premises are provided with and have access to adequate shelter, drinking water and appropriate food; and Ensure that any enclosure used for the purpose of keeping an animal is thoroughly cleaned at least once a week and effectively treated with an insecticide at least twice a year; and Comply with reasonable directions given by an authorised person to ensure that the keeping of the animal/s does not result in nuisance to occupiers of other land or premises, including
