CRITERIA FOR PRE-APPROVAL FOR BURIAL ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

Pre-approvals will only be permitted where the following criteria have been met

- The property must be freehold.
- The property must be no smaller than 40 hectares in size.
- The applicant must have a family association with the property of at least 30 years,
 - A current QLD title search has been included with this application as proof of family ownership and association.
 - Written approval from the owner of the land (as per the QLD title search) has been provided with this application approving burial on the property.
- Prior to any burial the applicant agrees to complete an Application for Burial on Private Property and adhere to the criteria of that application.
- The applicant must be able to satisfy the requirements of Council's *Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011*.

APPROVAL FOR BURIAL ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

Approval for Burial on Private Property will only be granted if there are no changes identified between when the pre-approval is granted and when the burial is to take place. Any changes to the property or ownership of the property may void pre-approval.

REGISTERED EASEMENT RECOMMENDATION

Council strongly recommends that, if approval is granted for a private burial plot, the property owner undertakes the process of creating a registered road easement through the property to the family gravesite and have this easement registered on the title. In the event that the property is ever sold, this easement will provide family with continued access to the family plot.
